Way to go, Martin!! We are so proud of you as you move on up to Room 2!

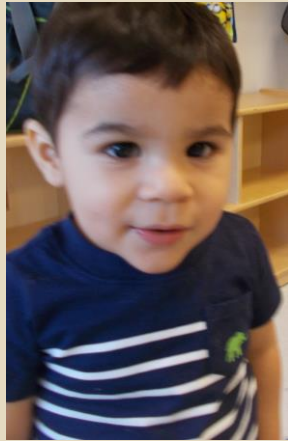


Room 2-Ms. Ana, Ms. Jenny & Ms. Aisha

Welcome Ethan, we are thrilled to welcome you into our class!



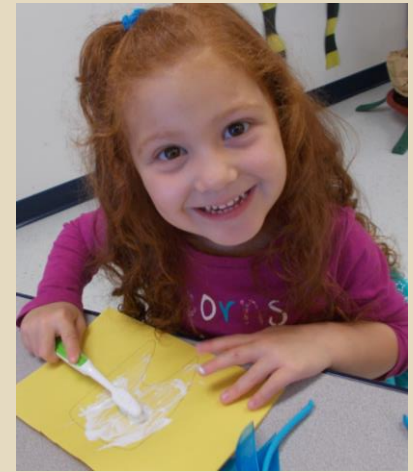
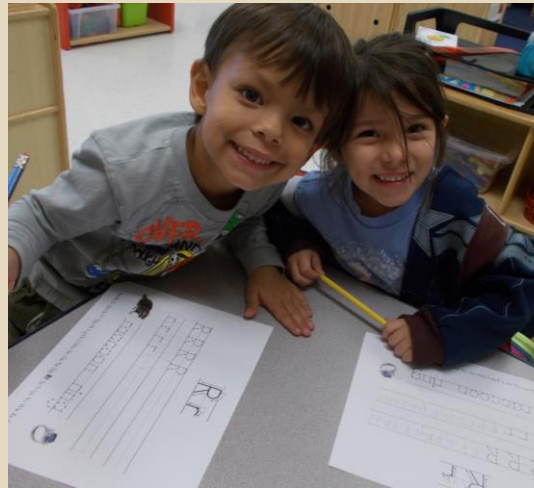
Room 8-Ms. Shana & Ms. Alisha
