Goodbye Leia, we will miss you!

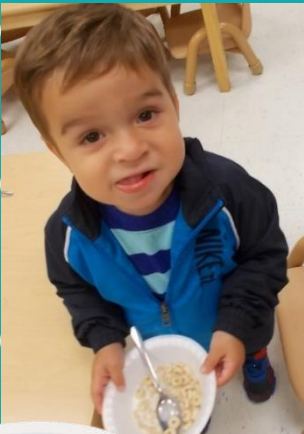


Room 4-Mrs. Ashley, Mrs. Miriam & Mrs. Kailey

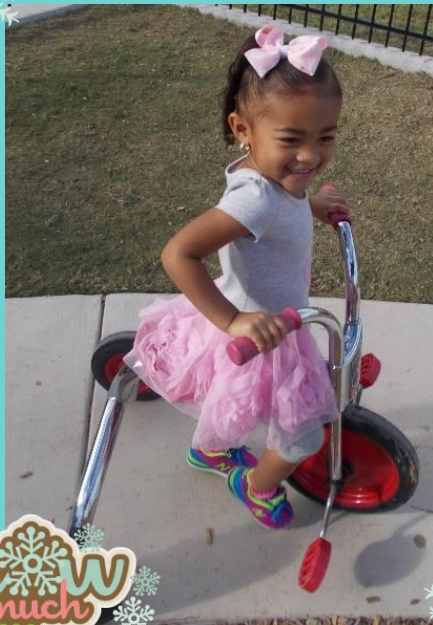
