

# Protect Children's Eyes

Children's eyes are more susceptible to UV exposure because the lenses in the eyes are clearer.

When children are outside, follow these steps:

- ~ Keep children younger than six months out of direct sunlight.
- ~ The sun's rays are strongest between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Limit or try to keep children out of the sun during these hours.
- ~ Many manufactures make fun frames for children. Get them in the habit early of wearing shades when they're outside.
- ~ Make sure your child wears a wide brimmed hat or a baseball cap, which provides some UV protection.
- ~Remind children to wear their sunglasses even on cloudy days. Most of the sun's rays can come through the clouds on an overcast day.
- ~ Teach children to never look directly at or stare at the sun.
