Fire and Ice Watermelon Salsa

Ingredients

3 Cups chopped watermelon

1/2 Cup chopped green bell pepper

2 Tablespoons of lime juice

2 Tablespoons chopped cilantro

1 Tablespoon chopped green onion

1 Tablespoon chopped jalapeño

1/2 Teaspoon of garlic salt

Directions

Take all ingredients and mix thoroughly in a large serving bowl. Once mixed place in the refrigerator to cool for 30 minutes. Add tortilla chips and you are ready to enjoy!
