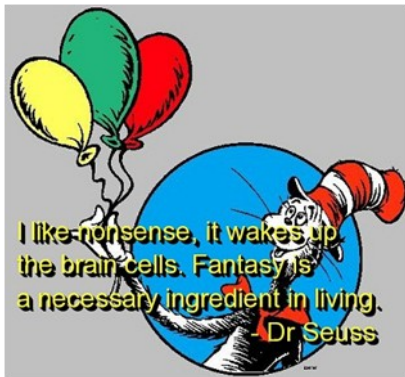

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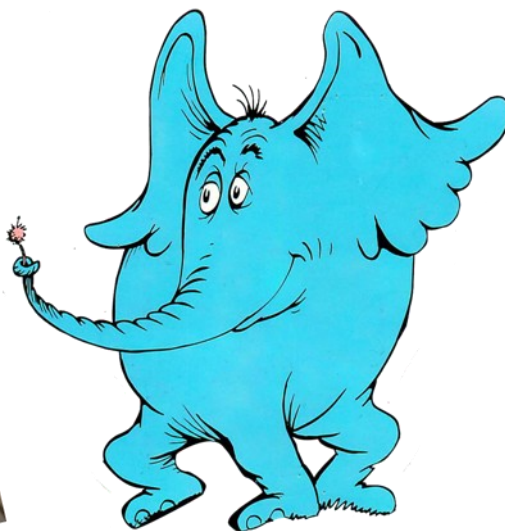
Infants/Toddlers - Rooms 1, 2, & 3

We will also be recognizing coins as well as adding and subtracting 1-10, indentifying and creating sets 1-20.



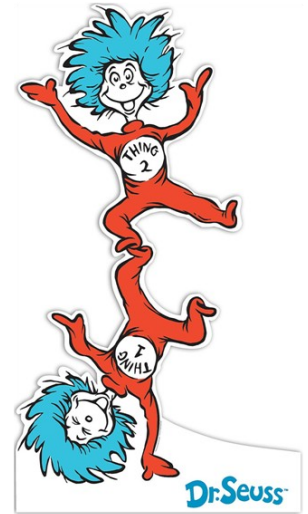
